

INFORMATION FOR SCHEDULE 7 RETAILERS

Enclosed is your Licence to sell poisons included in Schedule 7 by retail. Your licence is issued subject to the requirements set out in the Poisons Act 1964 and Regulations. Please read the conditions on your licence and note the following.

- Upon receipt of this licence you should forward a copy to your wholesale supplier.
- Schedule 7 poisons must only be sold in accordance with the conditions and restrictions listed in the Poisons Act Notice relating to Schedule 7 substances.
- The Schedule 7 poisons covered by your licence are limited to agricultural and/or veterinary chemicals. The purchaser must be a bona fide primary producer or the holder of a permit/voucher specifying that poison, or the holder of a pesticide operator's licence, specifying that poison. *The Agricultural & Veterinary Chemicals Code Act 1994* (Commonwealth) may stipulate further criteria relating to the sale of Schedule 7 Poisons.
- The sale must be entered in a register and must contain:
 1. Name and address of the purchaser.
 2. Date of sale.
 3. Name, strength and quantity of the product being supplied.
 4. Premises at which the poison is intended to be used.
 5. Signature of the purchaser.
- The storage of Schedule 7 poisons must be out of the reach of children, preclude the contamination of food and beverages, and only be accessible in the store to the owner of the business, an employee or an authorised purchaser. Poisons must not be sold to anyone who is apparently under sixteen years of age.
- Advice regarding serious spillage of any poison may be obtained by telephoning the Department of Environment and Conservation- Emergency Pollution Response Unit 1300 784 782 or after hours 1800 018 800.

Changes to the Poisons Licence

This Licence has been issued in your name on behalf of a business or company and at a specified site. Any proposed change to the details on your licence should be forwarded to the Department for the licence to remain valid. If you cease employment with the business for which you hold this licence you must notify the Department of Health in writing. If the business changes ownership a new application should be submitted by the new owners of the business. Schedule 7 Retail licences will not automatically be granted to new owners, their applications will be individually assessed, including the required experience.
