The *[applicant/respondent] applies for registration of the following agreement:

The applicant, (*name*), after receiving independent legal advice about this agreement, agrees to commute *[his/her] rights to compensation under the Workers Compensation Act from the respondent (*name of employer/insurer*) on the following terms—

Payment to applicant

*The respondent agrees to pay the applicant the settlement sum of (*amount*), in addition to payments made to or on behalf of the applicant to (*date*) by the respondent under the Workers Compensation Act, not later than 28 days after the date of this agreement.

or

*The respondent agrees to pay the applicant the sum of (*amount*) (being 90% of the settlement sum of (*amount*)) and pay the balance of 10% to Medicare Australia under the *Health and Other Services (Compensation) Act 1995* (Cwlth), in addition to payments made to or on behalf of the applicant to (*date*) by the respondent under the Workers Compensation Act, not later than 28 days after the date of this agreement.

Costs

*The respondent agrees to pay the applicant's costs *[agreed at (*amount*)/assessed in accordance with rule 3968 (4)].

*The parties agree to pay their own costs.

Rights commuted by applicant

- (1) The applicant agrees to commute *[his/her] rights to compensation under the Workers Compensation Act for injuries suffered by the applicant arising out of or in the course of *[his/her] employment with the respondent on *(date)* or between *(date)* and *(date)* as follows:
- *the applicant's entitlement to weekly compensation under part 4.3 of the Act for total or partial incapacity
 - *the applicant's entitlement to compensation for permanent injuries under part 4.4
 - *the applicant's entitlement to compensation for medical treatment, damages and other costs under part 4.5 of the Act
 - *the applicant's entitlement to compensation apart from this Act *(state)*
 - *the applicant's entitlement for any other amount *(state)*
- (2) *The commutation relates to the following injuries:
