Important Information for the applicant

The application to modify a fuel pipeline licence form is to be completed and returned to the Department of Transport, Coastal Facilities, 1 Essex Street, Fremantle or PO Box 402, Fremantle WA 6959, with the following:

Checklist of required items:

- The application fee; Current fees can be found on the Department of Transport website.
NOTE: only the application fee should be sent with the application form.
- A copy of the storage of dangerous goods licence from the Department of Mines and Petroleum;
- A current pressure test certificate indicating that the storage tank, fuel line and dispensing equipment are in good, safe repair and working order;
- Design drawings signed by a qualified practicing engineer with maritime experience;
- Dimensional sketch (A4 size) illustrating the overall structure dimensions, its location in relation to the applicant's property and the proposed amendment;
- Confirmation that the number is displayed on the jetty structure. If the number is not displayed, and you do not know the number, please contact the Maritime Licensing Officer on 9435 7626 to be provided one. The number should be placed on such parts or parts of the jetty so as to be clearly visible from the shore and the water; and
- Copies of all relevant approvals.

The applicant must consult with other relevant authorities such as local government, the Department of Environment and Conservation, WA Planning Commission, Swan River Trust etc. DoT will only approve a modification with the agreement of the other authorities. Various policies apply as to what is acceptable in different locations and circumstances. For further details of these please contact the Maritime Licensing Officer on 9435 7626.

The approval of the modification from DoT does not alleviate the need for the applicant to get any necessary development or building approval from other authorities with jurisdiction.
