**To successfully submit an applications for Petroleum Production Licence, the application must be made in the approved manner, which includes completion of this form, must be accompanied by the prescribed fee, and also include submission of detailed attachments providing the following information:-**

- (a) Plan showing particulars of the Location to which this application relates, the Location blocks in respect of which any previous application for a Licence or variation of a Licence has been made, and of the blocks in respect of which this application is made.
- (b) Plans showing the particulars of both the field outline and of the proposed facility layout.
- (c) Digitally mapped ArcGIS shapefiles detailing both the field outline and the proposed facility layout must also be provided. The coordinate datum is to be GDA94 and in a deprojected (latitude/longitude) format. The data should be emailed to [petroleum.mapping@dmp.wa.gov.au](mailto:petroleum.mapping@dmp.wa.gov.au) quoting the Exploration Permit/Drilling Reservation/Retention Lease title number as a reference.
- (d) Field Development Plan (3 copies), if not already submitted.
- (e) Particulars of the Applicant's proposal for work and expenditure in respect of each block in respect of which this application is made.
- (f) The prescribed fee, stated in the Schedule of Fees, is to be made **payable to the Department of Mines and Petroleum** through an Australian Bank or by Australian bank cheque and must be submitted with the application. Fees are non-refundable and subject to variation (including Consumer Price Index adjustments) and the current Schedule of Fees must be consulted prior to payment.
- (g) A statement of any other matters that the Applicant wishes the Minister to consider.
