

Extended trading authorisation on-premises licence

Information for applicants

1. This application form is for the licensee of an on-premises licence (other than for a vessel) who applies for an authorisation to extend trading hours, or who applies for a variation of extended trading hours already allowed.
2. Vessels should use form AM0075.
3. **You may need to complete a Community Impact Statement (CIS) before applying.** If required, the CIS must be attached to this application. Visit www.liquorandgaming.justice.nsw.gov.au for more information.
4. If the licence was granted before 30 October 2008, the licence will be subject to a 6-hour closure period if this application is approved. If the licence was granted on or after 30 October 2008, a 6-hour closure period already applies.
5. **The fee payable for this application depends on the hours of the extended trading, and is between \$300 and \$3,500.** A surcharge is applicable if paying by credit card. Fees are subject to change without notice. More details are available on page 6.
6. Complete all questions. If information is missing, we can ask you to supply the required information and/or documents to support the application. Failure to supply information can delay a decision on the application.
