 - Certification that all ammunition has been rendered inert (except UN Classification Code 1.45 up to 20mm calibre)
 - Ammunition safe keeping facilities
- Individual Application - DO NOT SEND PAYMENT WITH THIS APPLICATION**
If approved you will be sent a photographic advice to attend the RTA to have your permit card issued.
- Business, Club, Organisation - Fee \$75 (cheque, money order or credit card authority), with the application**

BUSINESS APPLICANTS ONLY - A completed P635 for each employee to be authorised by this permit AND proof of identity for each employee (if no other NSW firearms licence or permit is held or has been held).
