This is an **interactive** form and applies to a person on behalf of a business making application to conduct organised activities involving the use of paintball guns at a nominated location and to possess paintball guns for the purposes of operating the paintball field.

1. LOCATION AND DETAILS OF PAINTBALL GAME FIELD

Provide the address/location and size of the premises/land where the paintball games will be conducted and describe the business operation of the paintball field.

Attach a copy of the Development Approval from the relevant local consent authority or person responsible for the control of the land (eg council or landholder).

Provide a map and layout of the paintball field. See Chapter 7 of the Ranges Guide provided as a link on this permit page.

2. PUBLIC SAFETY MEASURES

Provide detailed information below of the measures that will be taken to ensure that all activities are conducted with proper regard for public safety.

4. FIREARMS SAFETY TRAINING

If you have never held a firearms licence or permit in NSW, or you do not currently hold an equivalent issued firearms licence or permit interstate, you are required to complete firearm safety training for longarms.

Attach a certificate of successful completion of an approved firearm safety training course for longarms (*if applicable*).



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5. PAINTBALL GUN SAFE KEEPING FACILITIES AND INSPECTION EVENT NUMBER

Provide information below on the arrangements for safe keeping and storage of paintball guns at the firearm safe keeping address nominated in your firearms permit application form. The safe storage must be inspected by police.

FURTHER INFORMATION

It is a serious offence under the *Firearms Act 1996* to make a statement or provide information in relation to an application that is false or misleading. By signing the Declaration on your firearms permit application form, you are certifying that ALL the information supplied in relation to this application is true and correct.

CHECKLIST - Make sure you have supplied ALL of the following required information:

All applicants are required to provide:

- A completed P634** 'Application for a Firearms Permit' form
- Proof of Identity** (*if no other NSW firearms licence or permit is held or has been held*).
- A Legitimate Reason** form with the relevant sections completed:
 - Address / location and size of the premises/land where the paintball games will be conducted.
 - A copy of the Development Approval
 - Details of the public safety measures
 - Details of the safe keeping facilities
 - Police safe storage inspection Event number
 - Firearm safety training certificate, *if applicable*
 - Fee \$500 (cheque, money order or credit card authority), with the application**

BUSINESS APPLICANTS ONLY - A completed P635 for each employee to be authorised by this permit AND proof of identity for each employee (*if no other NSW firearms licence or permit is held or has been held*) AND Safety Training Certificate, *if applicable*.

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
