During the course of this permit, if you wish to conduct laser games at locations other than those listed above, you must notify the Firearms Registry and provide a consent authority for the new location.

3. DETAILS OF THE FIREARMS TO BE USED

 - Details of the firearm safe keeping facilities
 - Safe Storage Inspection Event number
 - Fee \$75 (cheque, money order or credit card authority), with the application**
