

# BCC Entertainment Venues

## Activities requiring a permit

- boxing or wrestling contest, display or exhibition
- dog racing
- major sporting stadium
- amusement arcade
- aquatic leisure park
- basketball or netball
- billiard saloon
- cinema
- circus, including associated entertainments
- commercial swimming pool or spa
- drive-in theatre
- entertainment hall
- concert, lecture, public meeting hall
- dancehall, ballroom dancing, display of dancing
- enclosing sports premises except those listed above
- horse racing, trotting or pacing
- RNA Showgrounds
- motor vehicle/bike racing
- fetes, fairs, fleamarkets and markets (held regularly throughout a year - if held once a year must have an event permit)
- live artists not involving amplified music
- golf links, driving ranges and practice centres
- gymnasium or fitness centre
- indoor bowling (not a ten-pin bowling centre, skittles or bowling green)
- mechanical structure for amusement
- mini golf
- night club (not holding a liquor licence for whole of premises)
- amplified music concerts - venue for conducting concerts as a primary activity and inside a building
- indoor cricket, volleyball
- live music or entertainment of a minor nature not an amplified music concert
- riding school
- squash courts, tennis courts
- ten-pin bowling
- theatre and theatre restaurant
- outdoor sport and recreation centre
- zoo park
- outdoor bowls (not holding a liquor licence for whole of premises)
- reception lounges (includes for wedding receptions, birthdays and other parties)
- skating rink (including ice skating)
