### **Criteria for decision**

Before a disclosure exemption can be granted by the Director-General of DAFF, the Director-General must be satisfied that the details in the application for exemption are not required to be disclosed under another law of the State of Queensland and are not publicly available.

The Director-General must also be satisfied that the disclosure of details is likely to disadvantage the interest of –

- ## the applicant; or
- ## a member of an AEC for the applicant; or
- ## a proposed AEC for the applicant.

The disadvantage to any of the above will be weighed against the public interest of having the details disclosed.

The Director-General may grant a disclosure exemption for the whole or part of the registration details the subject of the relevant application.
