This form must be used to apply for a permanent identification device (PID) registry licence (Licence). If the Chief Executive grants the Licence, the Chief Executive may impose conditions on the Licence not inconsistent with the mandatory conditions. If the Chief Executive refuses to grant the Licence, or imposes conditions on the Licence, the Chief Executive must give the applicant an information notice for the decision.

The Chief Executive may, by notice, require the applicant to provide further information or documentation reasonably required to decide the application. A reasonable time period of at least 28 days will be stated in the notice for the applicant to comply. If the applicant does not comply with the requirement within the stated period in the notice, the applicant will be taken to have withdrawn their application.
