DOCUMENTS IN RELATION TO A SPECIAL PLUMBING PERMIT FOR TRADE WASTE SYSTEMS CONNECTED TO AN APPROVED DISPOSAL SYSTEM, OTHER THAN A SEWERAGE SYSTEM
