Standard Unsterilised Dog	\$88
Sterilised Dog – must provide a veterinarian certificate	\$40

Pensioner Rate: a 50% discount applies to the general registration categories. A pension card must be provided at the time of registration. The discount only applies to the first dog registered. No further discounts apply, not applicable to Health Care Card holders.

Obedience Trained: a \$5 discount applies to the general registration categories if your dog has completed Certificate 1 in obedience training. This discount is not to be used in conjunction with a pension discount.

Dog Owners Information

WHY REGISTER?

In accordance with Section 8(1) of the Dog Control Act 2000 it is a requirement for any dog over the age of six months to be registered. Failure to do so may result in an infringement notice being issued. Please note, this requirement is in addition to having your dog microchipped.

TRANSFER OF REGISTRATION

If you have changed municipalities within Tasmania you can transfer the current registration of your dog free of charge. To do this you will need to produce written evidence of the current registration, or the current registration tag.

COMPULSORY MICROCHIPPING

It is now a legal requirement for any dog over the age of six months to be microchipped. Failure to microchip your dog may result in an infringement notice being issued. Please note, you are still required to register your dog as well as having the dog microchipped. (Verification must be provided at the time of registration to show that the dog has been microchipped, eg veterinarian certificate.)

KENNEL LICENCE

A kennel licence is required if the owner has three or more dogs on a property. Please contact the Animal Management Unit on (03) 62 382 182 for further information or visit hobartcity.com.au to download an information pack.

DOGS IN PUBLIC PLACES

- In accordance with the provisions of the Dog Control Act 2000 a dog must be walked on a lead on any road related area. This includes pathways, nature strips and unsealed roads;
- Owners are required to pick up after their dog;
- You are not permitted to walk more than two dogs at a time on a footpath;
- Dogs must remain under effective control of the owner or person in charge of the dog at all times. This also includes when exercising your dog in a designated off lead area.

IMPOUNDING

If your dog is impounded, every effort will be made to return the dog home if it has the prescribed identification and if someone is on the premises. In the event the dog does not have the prescribed identification, the dog will be transported to the Hobart Dogs' Home at Risdon Vale. The Hobart Dogs' Home can be contacted on (03) 6243 5177. Please be aware that an infringement notice may also be issued in addition to fees paid at The Hobart Dogs' Home.

RESTRICTED BREED DOGS

In accordance with Section 29 of the Dog Control Act 2000 Restricted Breeds must be automatically declared as dangerous dogs. Restricted breeds are American Pit Bull Terrier (or Pit Bull Terrier), Fila Brasileiro, Dogo Argentino, Japanese Tosa, Perro de Presa Canario.
