EXPLANATORY NOTES - PLEASE READ CAREFULLY

- Any transfer of quota involving quota not originally issued to the transferee will require co-authorisation from the originating quota holder.
To be seasonally leased, quota units/carry over must be uncaught.
All quota units/pots which are transferred on a seasonal basis will automatically revert back to the original licence holder at the end of the quota year.

- If the fishing licence (rock lobster) has less than 15 rock lobster quota units permanently specified in the licence and does not have a fishing licence (giant crab) attached to it with at least 15 giant crab quota units authorised in it, the rock lobster licence is to be endorsed with a condition that prohibits the licence being used to take fish.
- The number of pots which can be used from a vessel under the rock lobster quota management system should not be confused with the number of pots you are permitted to carry aboard your vessel according to its length or tonnage as specified in Schedule 2 of the *Fisheries (Rock Lobster) Rules 2011*.
- A maximum of 200 quota units, either leased or owned, can be specified in a single licence.
- It is an offence for a licence holder to control more than 200 quota units either by ownership or leasing.
- Leased units cannot be re-transferred to another entitlement without the transfer being acknowledged by the original licence holder. A signature from the owner of the units is required on this transfer form.

Personal information will be collected from you for the purposes of maintaining a register of persons holding authorisations and fishing certificates pursuant to the Living Marine Resources Management Act 1995 and will be used by the Department for purposes permitted by this Act. Failure to provide this information may result in the inability to process your application or provide the service requested.

Your basic personal information may be disclosed to other public sector bodies where necessary or if required by law.

The address provided may be disclosed to the Tasmanian Seafood Industry Council (TSIC) to enable notification of the industry updates, annual general meeting, Board elections and to enable the Fishing Today magazine to be forwarded to you. Your personal information may also be disclosed to the Institute of Marine and Antarctic Studies (IMAS) for research and stock assessment purposes.

Personal information will be managed in accordance with the Personal Information Protection Act 2004 and may be accessed by the individual to whom it relates on request to the DPIPWE. You may be charged a fee for this service.
