



## Schedule of fees and charges

Effective 1 July 2015

### GST

Fees and charges highlighted with an asterisk (\*) include GST. All others are GST exempt.

### Grace period

Where a grace period relates to a licence for a major hazards facility, the provisions of regulation 34 of the Dangerous Goods Safety (Major Hazards Facilities) Regulations 2007 apply.

Where referenced for other licences, the grace period is the three months after the due date or the anniversary of the date that the licence was granted or last renewed.
