

## General Practice Education and Training Accreditation Collaborative Agreement

The Clinical Education and Training Institute (CETI) Medical Division (IMET) regulates facility and term accreditation for prevocational training in NSW and ACT. This role is delegated by the Medical Board of Australia and endorsed by the NSW and ACT Health Departments.

The [redacted] is applying to CETI to become an accredited facility for the Prevocational General Practice Placement Program. The practice agrees to adhere to the General Practice Prevocational Education and Training Standards for Trainers and General Practice. The accreditation process is in two stages:

1. provisional assessment against the Standards (1 year accreditation)
2. full assessment against the Standards (up to 3 years accreditation).

As the Prevocational General Practice Placements Program is a collaboration between a general practice, hospital and regional training provider, the accreditation process requires the support of all partners.
