#### **LICENCE FEES**

Licence applications will not be assessed until the prescribed licence fee of \$15,000 (no GST applies) has been received and cleared by the Commonwealth. An invoice for this fee will be issued via email following receipt of this application form – please do not pay until this invoice is received. Instructions on how to pay the licence fee will be on the invoice. The fee is payable for each licence period or part thereof.

During the term of a licence a levy of \$135 per metric tonne of methyl bromide imported will be payable within 60 days after the end of each calendar quarter.

*It is an offence under section 62 of the Ozone Protection and Synthetic Greenhouse Gas Management Act 1989 to provide a document that contains information that is false or misleading information in a material particular.*
