¹ Accreditation is granted to the Manager and is revoked should the Manager cease to be in day-to-day control of the saleyard. To maintain accreditation, a new application form in the name of the new manager must be submitted.

² Saleyard managers will be responsible for ensuring compliance by the agent groups working within the Saleyard. Action taken in the case of a breach could include the banning of a particular agent or of an entire group of agents from participating in EU sales, revoking the saleyard's accreditation or prosecution of the manager.

UNDERTAKINGS

1. I have a comprehensive, documented management system, which –
 - Enables the separation of EU eligible cattle from HGP treated cattle and cattle of uncertain 'HGP Free' status,
 - Establishes a record of the NLIS number or associated transponder number for all EU eligible cattle brought into the saleyard.
 - Establishes whether the cattle are purchased by an EU accredited producer or EU listed abattoirs or not.
 - Where the cattle are purchased by an EU accredited producer, establishes the Property Identification Code of that producer and advises the NLIS database of the purchased cattle,
 - Ensure that the NLIS database is advised of the NLIS number or associated transponder number of purchased EU eligible cattle leaving the 'closed system', and where available, the Property identification Code of the purchaser,
 - Ensures that purchasers of EU eligible cattle receive either the original or a copy of the accompanying EU Vendor Declaration,
 - Establishes a record of the EU Vendor Declaration number on the form accompanying EU eligible cattle,
 - Ensures that individuals working within the saleyard are aware of, and abide by, the management system,
 - Documents incidents of non-compliance and records the corrective action taken, ensures that internal auditing occurs to check compliance with the management system, and documents the results of the internal auditing.THIS MANAGEMENT PLAN IS AVAILABLE FOR AUDIT.

2. I undertake to abide by the arrangements documented and approved by AQIS in this management system.

3. I agree to allow persons authorised for the purpose under the *Export Control Act*, or officers of the European Commission, onto my saleyard to conduct audits from time to time to assess my compliance with the conditions of accreditation.

4. I agree to provide to the Secretary notification, in writing, of my intention to relinquish my accreditation should I decide to do so. I agree to provide to the Secretary notification, in writing, if I cease to be the manager of the saleyard.
