



The Motor Vehicle Repairs Act 1980 (the 1980 Act) was repealed by the Motor Dealers and Repairers Act 2013 (the 2013 Act) on 1 December 2014.

Under the 1980 Act, repairers licences could be held jointly by all partners in a business however under the new 2013 Act, a licence can only be held by one of the partners in a business. All of the partners that jointly hold a repairers licence are required to nominate only one partner to continue holding this licence when next renewing the licence however the nomination may be made earlier.

Only a partner who is currently a joint licensee can be nominated.

Please note that once the nomination has been made it cannot be changed. In the event that the nominated partner ceases to be a partner then one of the remaining partners, or a new partner would need to apply for a new licence.

All partners including the nominated partner must sign below to agree to the above nomination of the partner who is to hold the licence.
