The proposed vehicle must be a currently registered small passenger vehicle (a vehicle with a capacity of 9 seats or less including the driver), and have Class 16 MAIB premium.

The Transport Commission may approve a vehicle for use as a restricted hire vehicle for General RHV services if the vehicle is a suitable vehicle, being (please tick applicable vehicle):

- a motor vehicle that is unique, classic or customised and more than 30 years old; or
- a “street-rod”, being a motor vehicle that has been modified for safe road use and –
 - has a body and frame that were built before 1949; or
 - is a replica of a motor vehicle whose body and frame were built before 1949; or
- a veteran or vintage motor vehicle; or
- a motor cycle or tricycle; or
- that is capable of providing transport to, from or within a national park, as defined in the [Nature Conservation Act 2002](#), State reserve, as defined in the [Nature Conservation Act 2002](#), or other land similar to a national park or State reserve; and that has an access door adjacent to each outboard seating position.

This service will be restricted by licence conditions to operating only as described.
