POL-E3.3 Signs within Road Reserve



1 Objective

To specify Council's policy on street names within the road reserve.

2 Policy Statement

The Council policy relating to signs within the road reserve be extended to include street name signs:-

- 1.1 Street name signs shall be 1200mm x 200mm where located adjacent to major arterial roads and 1000mm x 150mm on local roads where it is intended to accommodate directional signs on the same set of pylons.
- 1.2 Midland sub-regional centre street name signs shall be green letters on a white reflective background with a Shire crest located at the end of the street name.
- 1.3 Guildford special design control area street signs to be white reflective lettering on a brown background.
- 1.4 Swan Valley street name signs shall be green letters on a white reflected background with the Shire crest at the end of the street name.
- 1.5 Street name signs within the remaining parts of the municipal district shall be black lettering on a white background with the Shire crest at the end of the sign. Special subdivisions such as Brigadoon and Ballajura may be exempted for this requirement subject to Council approval.
