IMPORTANT INFORMATION FOR DOG OWNERS

In 1976 extensive changes were made to the Dog Act in an effort to address dog related problems within our communities to encourage responsible dog ownership. Some of the more important changes are that owners be held responsible for **EFFECTIVELY** confining their dogs to their properties. This does not permit tethering (tying) up a dog on the premises. **Shire of Dandaragan DOGS Local Law requires an occupier of premises on which a dog is kept, must- (a) cause a portion of the premises on which the dog is kept to be fenced in a manner capable of confining the dog.**

Another is dealing with dog attacks. A dog does **NOT** have to bite a person or animal for the Local Government to consider it to be an attack under State Legislation. If a dog attacks or chases any person, or any animal owned or in the charge of another person, whether or not any injury is caused, every person liable for the control of the dog commits an offence.

In addition to the dogs registration tag being attached to a collar, the owner's details and contact number must also be attached to the collar. It is recommended that the name of the dog is engraved on this attached tag.

PLEASE NOTE

1. Definition of a **WORKING DOG** for concessional licencing purposes is as follows;
Dog used for droving or tending stock. (Owners may be required to demonstrate this)
2. Definition of a **PENSIONER** is as follows;
A person issued with a Pensioner Concession Card.
3. No more than **TWO** dogs to be kept on any premises over the age of three months.
4. **PLEASE advise the Shire if your circumstances change in anyway i.e. address, Contact Details, ownership, or Dog/s passing away / euthanaised.** (This will alleviate any unnecessary grief to you or your family at renewal time by receiving a notice for your beloved pet no longer here).
5. The person who is named on the front of this form, and signs this declaration is responsible for the dog and must be over 18 years of age.
6. Dog owners are also reminded that dogs aged three (3) months and over must be registered at all times. A dog, which has been seized and impounded for wandering, will not be released until all associated fees are paid and the dog is registered or proof of registration is provided.
