You will need to supply a copy of your Current Public liability Insurance

You may not

- 1) Call the licensees wares or cause to make outcry, noise or disturbance likely to be a nuisance or cause annoyance to any person in the vicinity.
- 2) Obstruct the free passage of pedestrians or vehicles on any footpath or roadway.
- 3) Act in an offensive manner, or participate in any illegal activity.
- 4) You will be required to obtain written permission from any Aboriginal Community before entering to hawk at the relevant community. A copy of that written approval must be forwarded to the Shire office.

Rubbish/Waste Disposal

The stall must have appropriate rubbish bins or bags to accommodate all types and volumes of waste generated from your activities, including some for the public.
